  - (2) The applicant has been a director of research project granted by the National Science Council in the last three years.
- 3. Application professor is required to meet the eligibility criteria, "Qualification of Distinguished Professor" (see Appendix I)
- 4. The applicant is required to have the ability of teaching academic subjects in English language (English as a medium of instruction).

# **Application Materials:**

- 1. The recruitment is conducting under the relevant regulations of the school and the Department.
- 2. Application materials (not returnable)
  - (1) Application Documents: curriculum vitae, autobiography.
  - (2) Copy/copies of certificate of ID card, doctoral diploma, teacher certificate, academic transcript.
  - (3) Doctoral dissertation and publications in the last five years (Abstract both in Mandarin and English).

- (4) Syllabus of courses taught at the current position and at least four courses that the applicant will be offering in the department.
- (5) Future research directions and contributions to the department.

The applicants will be informed of an interview after the research committee reviewed the applicants' materials and determine whether the applicants meet the required qualifications.

- B. Has published an original academic thesis in journals with Impact Factor > 25 (such as Science, Nature and Cell) and is the first author or corresponding author of the thesis.
- C. Been invited to exhibit by an international arts body; or had works collected by international arts bodies; or has finished in the top three in international sport competitions, or been granted important awards and performed outstandingly in any production.
- D. In the most recent three years, the applicant has been a candidate for the NSC Outstanding Award, or has performed in the top 5% in all sub-academic fields (attach relevant certificate).
- E. In the most recent three years, the applicant has obtained more than an annual average (Per case) of NTD 2.5 million in industry contributions through industry-academia collaboration programs.
